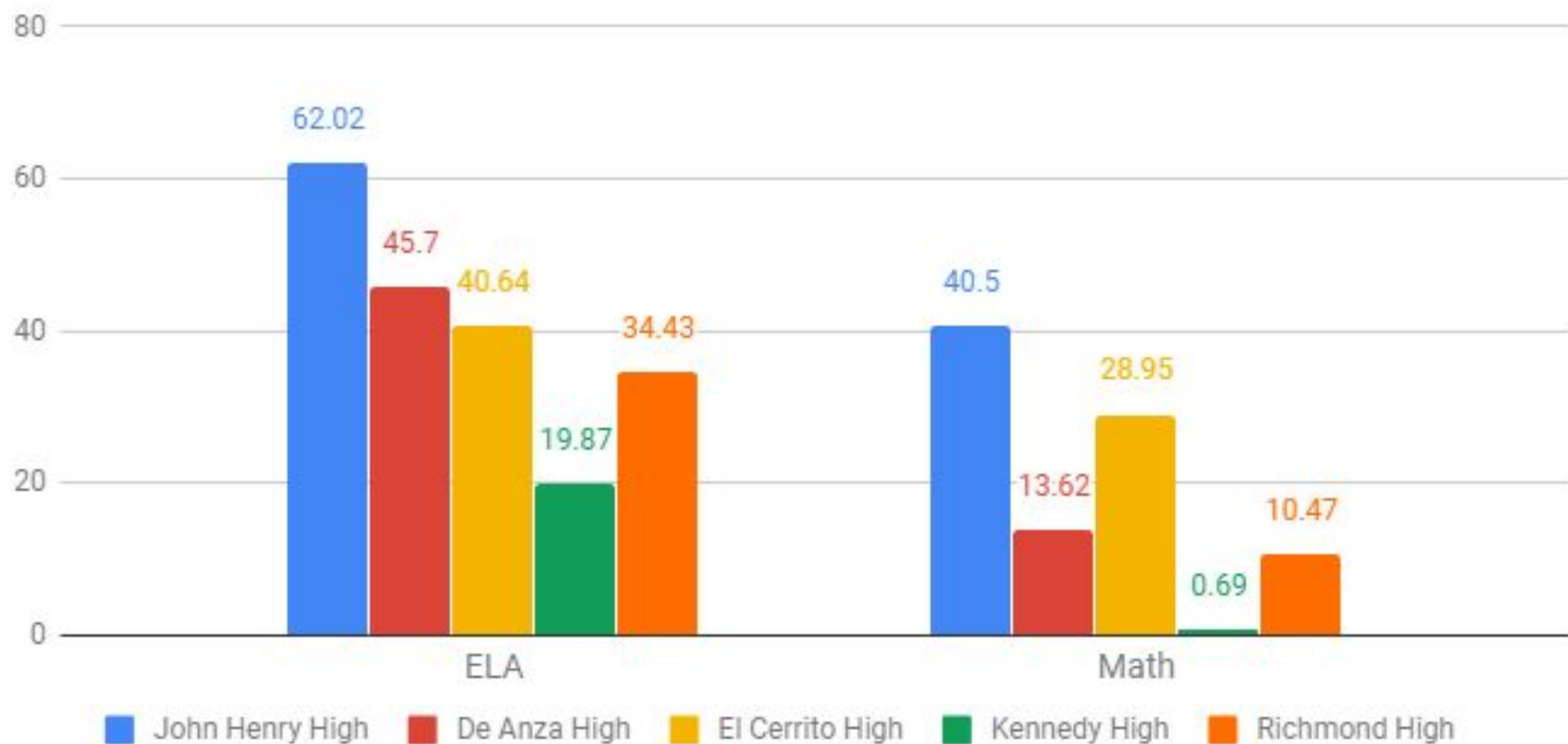

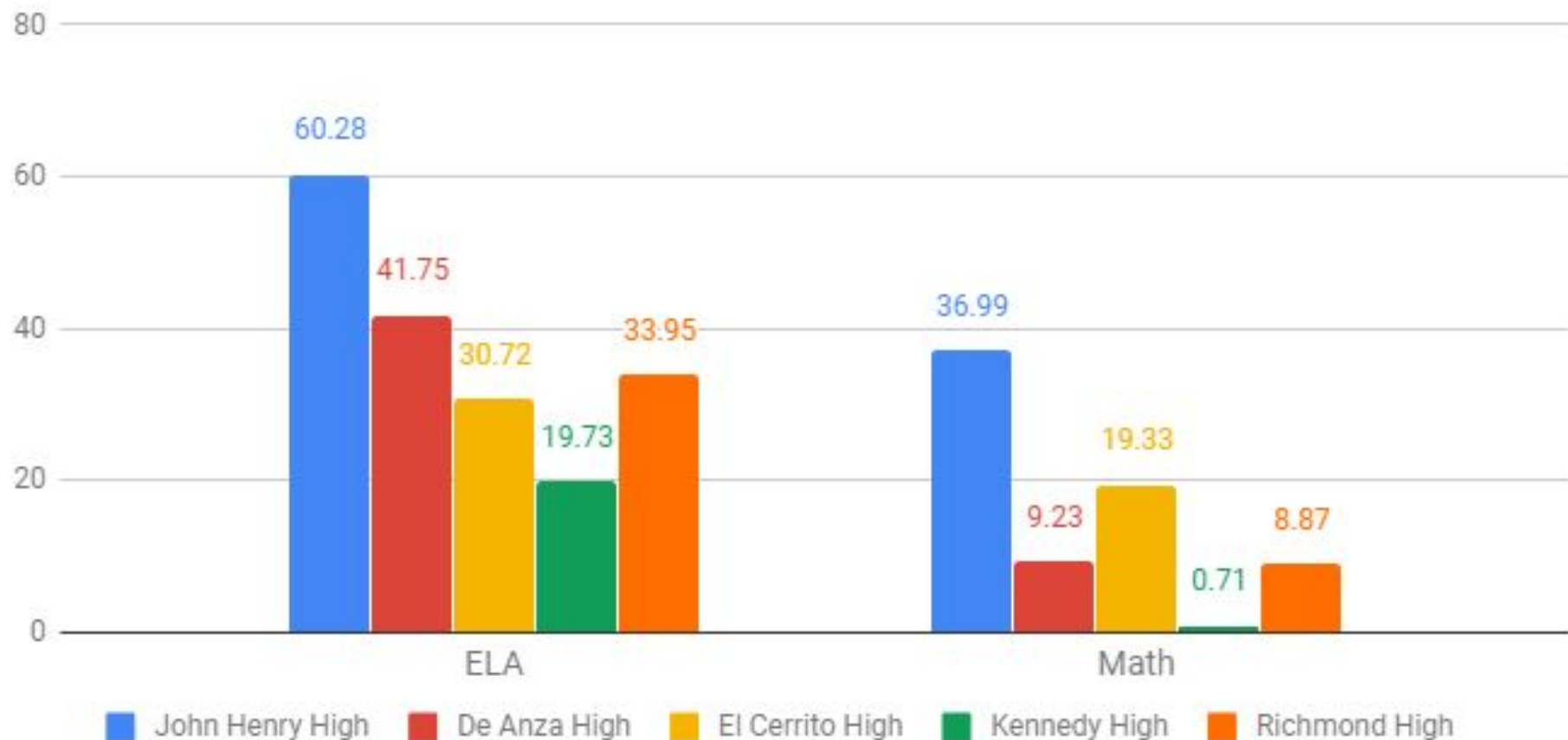

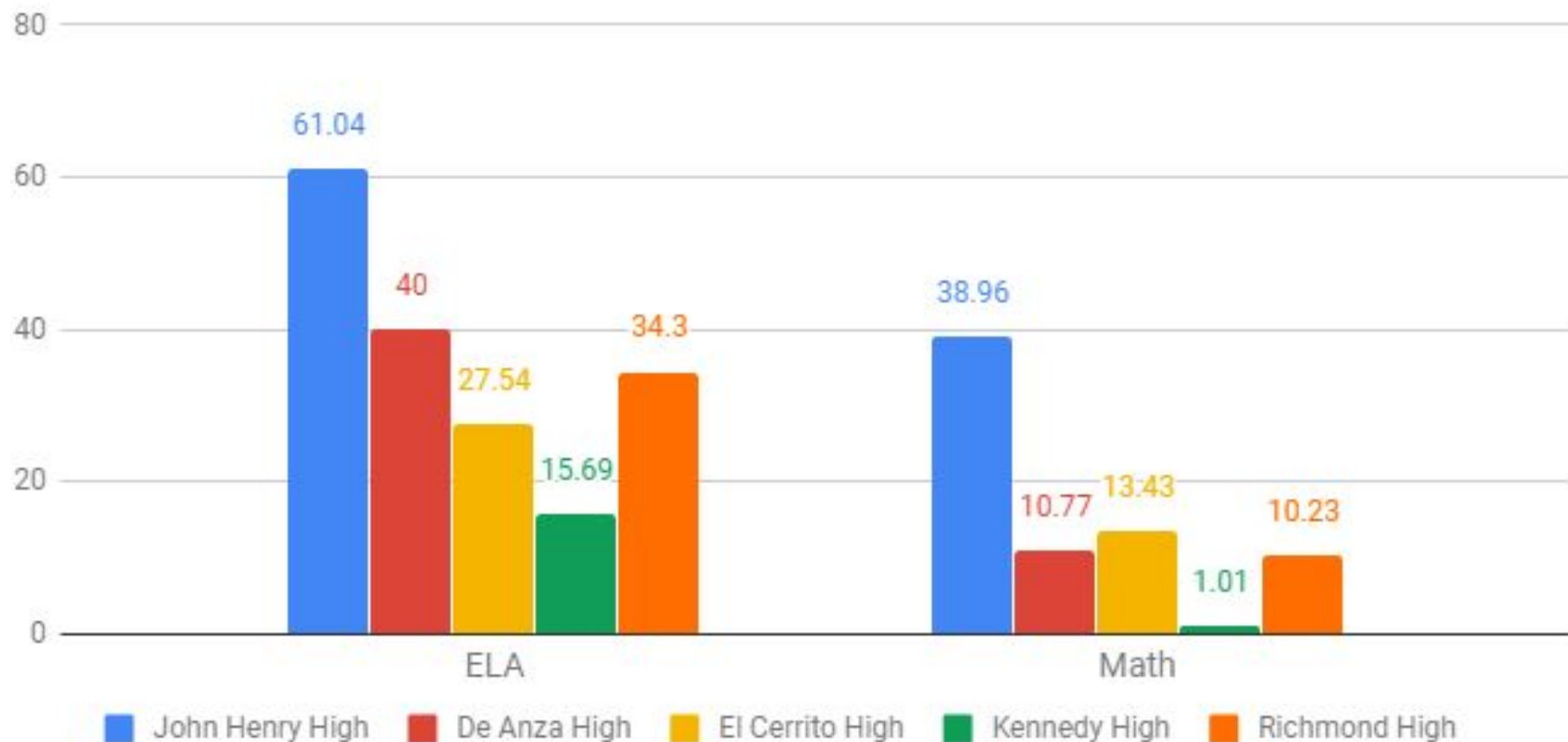
2018 CAASPP Results Comparison - All Students

AP Data

- Last year was the first year that students took AP exams that were tied to an AP class. Our result was 12% of students scoring a 3 or above.
- Last year, we only had 1 AP class, AP US History. There were 24 students who took AP exams.
- This year, we added 4 new AP courses at our school: AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP Spanish Language, and AP Calculus AB.
- We expect our data to increase next year due to the increased funding for AP teachers to attend professional development conferences given by the College Board, our increased focus on teacher development through observation, feedback, and coaching sessions, and our commitment to pair teachers up with seasoned/veteran AP teachers from our sister school.
